

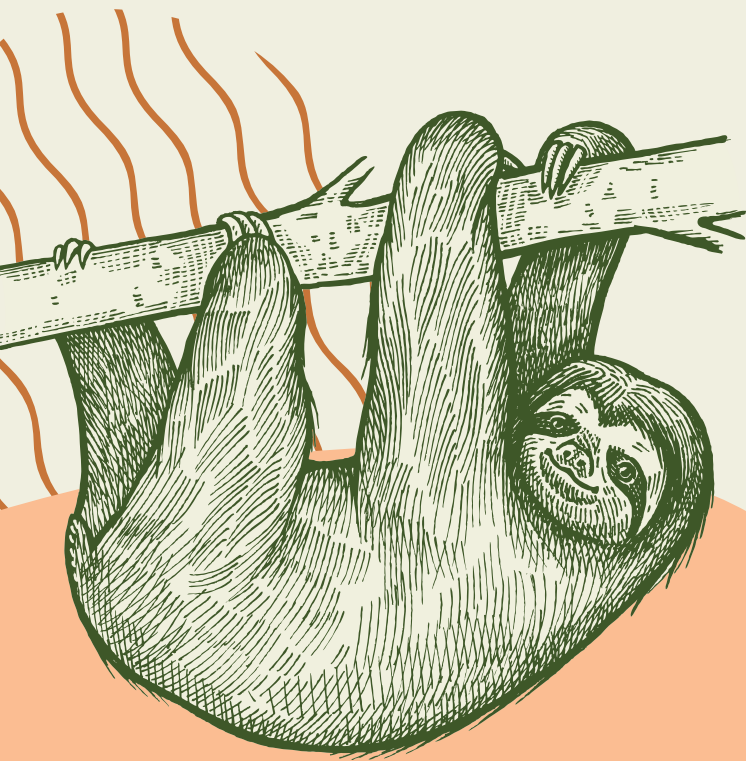
Amazonia Forever Private Sector in 2025

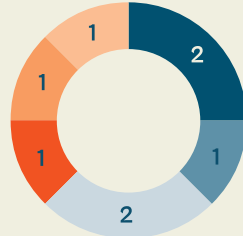

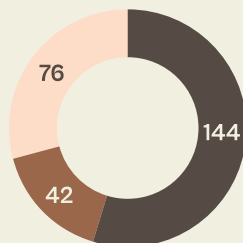


Sector Breakdown

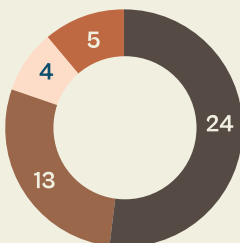

Dimensions for Success

1 Scaling Investments Across Amazonia

- Closed 8 projects (US\$262M) across 5 countries and a broader sector mix.
- Expanded the portfolio beyond traditional nature-based solutions.
- Adopted a dollar risk approach to unlock first-of-kind investments, paving the way for replication across the region.

2 Building Capacity & Generating Knowledge

- 46 advisory services and upstream projects spanning all Amazonia countries.
- Approved IDB Invest's first TC under the new TC Facility, launching a more strategic approach to project origination.
- Close coordination with IDB's ACU team to upstream work with broader Amazonia Forever objectives.

3 Enhancing Regional Coordination

- MoU with TNC signed and under implementation to advance restoration, sustainable cattle ranching and socio-bioeconomy opportunities.
- Amazonia CEO Task Force: pan-Amazonian private sector platform launched at COP30 to shape a forward-looking vision for the region.
- COP30: Positioned IDB Invest as a leading private sector voice in the Amazon, with 8 events and 2 publications.



Unlocking New Markets

US\$ 1.5M TC to prepare 15 high-impacts projects in reforestation, bioeconomy and sustainable value chains.

Amazonia Finance Network

63 members mobilized, supporting 20 transactions and 14 advisory projects across the region.

New donors to IDB Invest

Expanded donor base supporting nature-based solutions, with potential to scale across new regions and sectors.

Indigenous Talent and Voice

Pilot program empowering indigenous talent and strengthening community voices through storytelling and digital tools.
